**Specific duties include but are not limited to:**

- Attend a one-hour, paid orientation on April 21, 2022
- Collaborates with referring school staff about appropriate instructional programs
- Acquires instructional materials from students' referring teacher(s) or specialist(s)
- Implements an instructional program based on student IEPs
- Uses a variety of teaching materials to meet the needs of each student
- Supervises students in classrooms, playgrounds, lunchrooms, and during the loading/unloading of buses
- Provides direction for paraprofessional(s) assigned to the classroom
- Provides non-academic support to meet students' needs, i.e., lifting/positioning, personal hygiene, toileting and diapering, tube feeding and catheterization
- Documents student progress and closes out IEP goals/objectives identified for ESY
- Returns ESY outcomes to sending schools

**Elementary and Secondary Teacher Schedule and Rate of Pay:**

- All Educators hired for this position are required to attend the planning day at their site on June 10, 2022. (4 hours total)
- The program will run from Monday, June 13, 2022 to Friday, July 8, 2022, @ \$40.45 per hour
- Workdays will be Monday through Friday, 4.5 hours a day
