**Specific duties include but are not limited to:**

- Attends a one-hour, paid orientation on April 21, 2022
- Assists in planning, instruction towards goals/objectives, and organization of instructional materials and equipment
- Assists with planning and implementing behavior management
- Assists with determining best practice in transition activities, e.g. bus, lunch and playground
- Promotes positive interaction with parents and staff
- Provides for students’ non-academic needs such as lifting/positioning, personal hygiene, diapering/toileting, tube feeding and catheterization
- Reports concerns to the lead teacher and/or Student Services Manager or Coordinator
- Is trained in Nonviolent Crisis Intervention (NCI) and strategies to support students’ positive learning.
- Only one person will be hired for this itinerant position

**Schedule and Rate of Pay:**

- The Paraprofessional hired for this position is required to attend the planning day at a site/sites on Friday, June 10, 2022.
- The program will run from Monday, June 13, 2022 through Friday, July 8, 2022 @ \$20.18 an hour.
- Workdays will be Monday through Friday, 4.5 hours a day
