Job Title:	Paraprofessional Itinerant Community (WES)

Specific duties include but are not limited to:

- Attends a two-hour, paid orientation
- Attend the WES Training
- Assists certificated staff in planning, implementation, direct instruction, and supervision of students
- Assists students within schools, the community, and on job sites (this could be outside)
- Follows directives of licensed staff
- Makes decisions independently
- Assists with public transportation travel training
- Provides for students’ non-academic needs, i.e., lifting/positioning, personal hygiene, diapering/toileting, tube feeding and catheterization

Schedule and Rate of Pay:

- The rate of pay for this position is: \$20.18 an hour
- Attends a two-hour, paid orientation (Date/Time TBD)
- Attend the WES Training (Date/Time TBD)
- The program will run from Monday, June 1 through Friday, August 6, 2021
- There will be a WES training (Date/Time TBD) that you will need to attend
- Workdays and hours will vary Monday through Friday. The maximum amount of hours that will be worked in any given day will be 7 hours. *Remote will look differently and will be determined as the need arises.
