Job Title:	Paraprofessional Itinerant Autism
Job Requirements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Previous experience working with students on the autism spectrum • Works independently and flexibly • This position requires that the person can interact with students with autism in a positive, empathetic manner • Implements environmental changes as necessary and uses positive behavioral intervention techniques • Must have current driver’s license, & auto insurance with coverage meeting district requirements • An Associate's Degree, 48 college semester credit hours, a BS/BA degree, or meets No child Left Behind requirements <p style="text-align: center;">IMPORTANT</p> <p style="text-align: center;">All educators are required to have a current NCI Certification through July 8, 2022</p>

Specific duties include but are not limited to:

- Attends a one-hour, paid orientation on April 21, 2022
- Supports the educational and behavioral needs of students with autism in school settings
- Assists in the development of materials including visual schedules and activities
- Assists in modifying and/or designing and implementing adaptations within the school settings
- Assists with observations and data collection of students with mild to severe behavioral issues
- Assists in record keeping and implementation of computer software programs
- Communicates with ESY staff about student progress
- Is trained in Nonviolent Crisis Intervention (NCI) and strategies to support students’ positive learning.
- Only one person will be hired for this itinerant position

Schedule and Rate of Pay:

- The Paraprofessional hired for this position is required to attend the planning day at a site/sites on Friday, June 10, 2022.
- The program will run from Monday, June 13, 2022 through Friday, July 8, 2022 @ \$20.18 per hour.
- Workdays will be Monday through Friday, 4.5 hours a day.
